

## HANCOCK COUNTY ORDINANCE NUMBER 17

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING PRECINCT BOUNDARIES IN HANCOCK COUNTY

BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of Hancock County, Iowa

WHEREAS each county board of supervisors shall make any changes in precinct boundaries as determined by the latest federal decennial census and necessary to comply with Sections 49.3, 49.4, 49.5, 49.6, and 49.7, Code of Iowa, and,

WHEREAS, the precinct boundaries shall become effective on January 15 of the second year in which the census was taken and shall be used for all subsequent elections, and

WHEREAS, each county board of supervisors shall file with the state commissioner of elections the populations of the election precincts as determined by the last federal census, a description of the county precincts, and a map showing the boundaries of the precincts.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Hancock County Board of Supervisors that the following is Hancock County's precincting by name, precinct description and total population according to the 2000 federal decennial census and in compliance with Sections 49.3, 49.4, 49.5, 49.6 and 49.7, Code of Iowa:

AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE NUMBER 17**

TITLE: AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING PRECINCT BOUNDARIES IN HANCOCK COUNTY

Purpose of amendment: To accurately record population totals in precincts #9 and #10.

BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of Hancock County, Iowa

WHEREAS each county board of supervisors shall make any changes in precinct boundaries as determined by the latest federal decennial census and necessary to comply with Sections 49.3, 49.4, 49.5, 49.6, and 49.7, Code of Iowa, and,

WHEREAS, the precinct boundaries shall become effective on January 15 of the second year in which the census was taken and shall be used for all subsequent elections, and

WHEREAS, each county board of supervisors shall file with the state commissioner of elections the populations of the election precincts as determined by the last federal census, a description of the county precincts, and a map showing the boundaries of the precincts.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Hancock County Board of Supervisors that the following is Hancock County's precincting by name, precinct description and total population according to the 2000 federal decennial census and in compliance with Sections 49.3, 49.4, 49.5, 49.6 and 49.7, Code of Iowa:
