The Hancock County, Iowa, Board of Supervisors met in adjourned session on the above captioned date pursuant to adjournment with Supervisors Florence (Sis) Greiman, Ron Sweers, and Jerry J. Tlach present. Absent: none.

The minutes of April 10, 2015 meeting were read and approved.

On motion by Supervisor Greiman, seconded by Supervisor Sweers and carried unanimously, the Board gave approval to the following: Signed letter of intent for granting proposed sanitary sewer easement in the east half of section 11, Madison Township when development of Forest City Rail Industrial Park occurs. Quarterly reports of the Hancock County Sheriff and Hancock County Recorder for the period ending March 31, 2015. Utility permit for Winnebago Cooperative Telecom Association, Lake Mills, Iowa, for fiber optic cable beginning on north side of Highway 18 on the west side of Vail Avenue thence south to 240th Street.

On motion by Supervisor Sweers, seconded by Supervisor Greiman and carried unanimously, the Board gave approval to the following: Signed Employee Benefit Systems Service Agreement for Run-Out Claims Administration for Hancock County.

On motion by Supervisor Greiman, seconded by Supervisor Sweers, the Board unanimously approved the following Resolution:

RESOLUTION FOR ESTABLISHMENT OF AREA SERVICE “C” ROAD

Hancock County Resolution # 4-13-2015

WHEREAS, Hancock County desires to classify certain roads on the area service system in the County to provide for a minimal level of maintenance and access by means of a gate or barrier; and

WHEREAS, the County, after consultation with the County Engineer, has the authority to specify certain roads within the County as Area Service “C” roads pursuant to Iowa Code Section 309.57; and

WHEREAS, the only persons who will have access rights to the roads shall be:

- (1) the owner, lessee, or person in lawful possession of any adjoining land,
- (2) the agent or employee of the owner, lessee or person in lawful possession of any adjoining land,
- (3) any peace officer,
- (4) any magistrate,
- (5) any public employee whose duty it is to supervise the use or perform maintenance of the road,
- (6) any agent or employee of any utility located upon the road.

WHEREAS, the minimal level of maintenance will be as follows:

1. Blading. Blading or dragging will not be performed on a regular basis.
2. Snow and Ice Removal. Snow and ice will not be removed, nor will the road surface be sanded or salted on a regular basis.
3. Signing. Signing shall not be continued or provided. ALL AREA SERVICE LEVEL C ROADS SHALL BE IDENTIFIED WITH A SIGN AT ALL POINTS OF ACCESS TO WARN THE PUBLIC OF THE LOWER LEVEL MAINTENANCE.
4. Weeds, Brush, and Trees. Mowing or spraying weeds, cutting brush and tree removal will not be performed on a regular basis. Adequate sight distances will not be maintained.
5. Structures. Bridges and culverts may not be maintained to carry legal loads. Upon failure or loss, the replacement structure will be appropriate for the traffic thereon.
6. Road Surfacing. There will be no surfacing materials applied to Area Service System C Roads on a regular basis.
7. Shoulders. Shoulders will not be maintained on a regular basis.
8. Crown. A crown will not be maintained on a regular basis.
9. Repairs. There will be no road repair on a regular basis.
10. Uniform Width. Uniform width for the traveled portion of the road will not be maintained.
11. Inspections. Regular inspections will not be conducted.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF HANCOCK COUNTY that this County does hereby establish the road described as an Area Service "C" road, with restricted access and a minimal level of maintenance.

That portion of Maple Avenue, Road #517, originally established on August 4, 1927 (See Road Record Book 1, Page 106) all lying between Section 31-97-24 and Section 36-97-25 of Hancock County, Iowa, commencing at the SE Corner of Section 36-97-25, 280th Street, and thence running northerly one (1) mile to the NE Corner of Section 36-97-25, 290th Street.

No further business to come before the Board, motion made to adjourn at 11:10 a.m. by Supervisor Sweers and carried. All Supervisors present voting, "Aye," session to adjourn and will meet again on April 20, 2015.
