The Hancock County, Iowa, Board of Supervisors met in adjourned session on the above captioned date pursuant to adjournment with Supervisors Florence (Sis) Greiman, Ron Sweers, and Jerry J. Tlach present. Absent: none.

The minutes of April 11, 2016 meeting were read and approved.

On motion by Supervisor Tlach, seconded by Supervisor Greiman and carried unanimously, the Board gave approval to the following: Second amendment to the Cooperative Reimbursement Agreement with Floyd County (Host) and Department of Human Services.

On motion by Supervisor Greiman, seconded by Supervisor Tlach, was the following: Insurance rates for employees same as the union agreement and receive longevity according to longevity schedule as in union agreement. Ayes: None. Nays: Greiman, Sweers, Tlach.
