The Hancock County, Iowa, Board of Supervisors met in adjourned session on the above captioned date pursuant to adjournment with Supervisors Florence (Sis) Greiman, Ron Sweers, and Jerry J. Tlach present. Absent: none.

The minutes of April 17, 2017 meeting were read and approved.

On motion by Supervisor Sweers, seconded by Supervisor Tlach, and carried unanimously, the Board gave approval to the following: Denied fireworks display permit for Floyd B. Jefson, Forest City, due to the application being applied for as an individual as per recommendation of County Attorney and requirement of application. Signed contract with Central Iowa Dirt & Demo, LLC, Kamrar, Iowa, for the repairs of Drainage District No. 57 Main Tile Repairs, for the amount of \$62,141. Approved the Designated Healthcare Provider Policy. Accepted the quote of \$150 from Luke Noble for the mowing of the lawn at the former Duncan Heights property one time.

On motion by Supervisor Tlach, seconded by Supervisor Sweers, and carried unanimously, the Board gave approval to the following: Hiring of Kaleb Bruggeman, summer help in the Secondary Road Department, effective May 8, 2017 at \$10.50 per hour, hiring of Jerald Weiskamp, summer help in the Secondary Road Department, effective May 8, 2017 at \$13.00 per hour, and hiring of Sam Cataldo, summer help in the Secondary Road Department, effective May 15, 2017 at \$10.50 per hour.

On motion by Supervisor Sweers, seconded by Supervisor Tlach and carried unanimously, the Board gave approval to the following Resolution:

## **RESOLUTION**

### **Structural Embargo**

**WHEREAS:** The Board of Supervisors is empowered under authority of Sections 321.236 Sub. (8), 321.255 and 321.471 to 321.473 to prohibit the operation of vehicles or impose limitations as to the weight thereof on designated highways or highway structures under their jurisdiction, and

**WHEREAS:** The Hancock County Engineer has caused to be completed the Structure Inventory and Appraisal of certain Hancock County structure in accordance with the National Bridge Inspection Standards and it has been determined that an adjustment of the structural load restrictions is needed to allow for correct operating stresses.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Hancock County Board of Supervisors that:

Local Structure #9144 on Ladd Avenue over the West Branch of the Iowa River between Sections 11 and 12, T-97N, R-25W, Crystal Township is closed because of

severely decayed, crushing and flexing piles. Signs shall be erected advising of the bridge closure.

No further business to come before the Board, motion made to adjourn at 10:15 a.m. by Supervisor Tlach and carried. All Supervisors present voting, "Aye," session to adjourn and will meet again on April 25, 2017.
