The Hancock County, Iowa, Board of Supervisors met in adjourned session on the above captioned date pursuant to adjournment with Supervisors Florence (Sis) Greiman, Ron Sweers, and Jerry J. Tlach present. Absent: none.

The minutes of July 17, 2017 meeting were read and approved.

On motion by Supervisor Tlach, seconded by Supervisor Sweers, and carried unanimously, the Board gave approval to the following: Assets in the Hands of the County Treasurer as of June 30, 2017. Allowance and disallowance of various homestead and military credit applications and Disabled Veteran homestead tax credit applications.

On motion by Supervisor Sweers, seconded by Supervisor Tlach, and carried unanimously, the Board gave approval to the following: Allowance and disallowance of various business property tax credit applications. Commercial Lease for 545 State Street, Suite # 1, Garner with Hancock County Health System. Approved Skott & Anderson Architects as architect's to prepare an architect's conceptual design of vehicle storage/ maintenance/ Engineer's Office facility, not to exceed \$15,000. Resolution
Removal of Stop Sign

WHEREAS the review of the road intersection of Nash Avenue and 231st Street indicates the elimination of an intersection since 231st Street East of Nash Avenue was never established as a roadway.

AND WHEREAS since 231st Street was never established as a roadway it eliminates the need to maintain a stop sign at this location.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Hancock County Board of Supervisors that the resolution adopted on the establishment of the stop sign locations by said Board of Supervisors on April 17th, 2017 be amended as follows:

1. That the Stop Sign located at the previous intersection of Nash Avenue and 231st Street be removed.

ROAD CLOSING RESOLUTION

As per Section 306.41 Code of Iowa be it resolved that the Board of Supervisors of Hancock County hereby declare closed temporarily the following roads in Hancock County due to construction, reconstruction, maintenance or natural disaster. This resolution shall become effective upon placement of temporary road closure signs and shall expire when the said temporary signs are removed upon completion of said project.

160th Street/B55 between Sec. 31-95-25 and Sec. 6-94-24
(Between Ford and Hill Avenue)

On motion by Supervisor Tlach, seconded by Supervisor Greiman, the Board gave approval to the following resolution:

RESOLUTION

ESTABLISHING SPEED LIMIT ON R35(JAMES AVENUE) FROM BRITT CORPORATE LIMIT TO 2600' SOUTH IN HANCOCK COUNTY, IOWA

WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors is empowered under authority of Sections 321.255 and 321.285(4), of the Code of Iowa, to determine upon the basis of an engineering and traffic investigation that the speed limit of any secondary road is greater than is reasonable and proper under the conditions existing, and may determine and declare a reasonable and proper speed limit, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Hancock County Board of Supervisors that the speed limit be established and appropriate signs erected at the locations described as follows:

On R35(James Avenue) from Britt Corporate Limit to 2600 feet South in Hancock County, Iowa;

North & South Bound Traffic

1. 35 MPH from 340 feet South of the Britt Corporate Limit changing back to 55 MPH at 2,260 feet South

This Resolution shall be in effect when the signs have been erected
