The Hancock County, Iowa, Board of Supervisors met in adjourned session on the above captioned date pursuant to adjournment with Supervisors Florence (Sis) Greiman, Ron Sweers, and Jerry J. Tlach present. Absent: none.

The minutes of February 29, 2016 meeting were read and approved.

On motion by Supervisor Tlach, seconded by Supervisor Greiman and carried unanimously, the Board gave approval to the following: Set Monday, March 21, 2016 at 10:00 a.m. as the date and time for a public hearing with master matrix scoring on one new swine confinement building to be built in at existing swine confinement facility in Section 28, Madison Township by A & D Pork, LLC.

On motion by Supervisor Greiman, seconded by Supervisor Tlach and carried unanimously, the Board gave approval to the following: Class C liquor license with outdoor service & Sunday sales for Slippery Elm, Inc. doing business as Slippery Elm Golf Course. Hancock County Secondary Road's Iowa Department of Transportation budget for Fiscal Year 2016-2017 and Hancock County Secondary Road's Iowa Department of Transportation 5 year construction program for Fiscal Years 2017-2021.

On motion by Supervisor Greiman, seconded by Supervisor Tlach and carried unanimously, the Board gave approval to the following Resolution:

### **ROAD EMBARGO RESOLUTION**

Whereas local authorities with respect to highways under their jurisdiction may by ordinance or resolution prohibit the operation of vehicles upon any such highway or impose restrictions as to the weight of vehicles to be operated upon any such highway, for a total period of not to exceed ninety days in any one calendar year, whenever any said highway by reason of deterioration, rain, snow or other climatic conditions will be seriously damaged or destroyed unless the use of vehicles thereon is prohibited or the permissible weights thereof reduced.

Now therefore, be it resolved that by a resolution an embargo period will be set from 12 o'clock noon on March 14, 2016 to 12 o'clock noon on June 12, 2016 and at any time during this period an embargo to limit load to five (5) tons per axle on any Hancock County roads will become effective upon posting said road.

On motion by Supervisor Greiman, seconded by Supervisor Tlach and carried, the Board authorized the County Auditor to issue checks for the claims on file this date, March 7, 2016. A full listing of all claims paid in March, 2016 will be published in the March 21, 2016 minutes.

No further business to come before the Board, motion made to adjourn at 10:00 a.m. by Supervisor Tlach and carried. All Supervisors present voting, "Aye," session to adjourn and will meet again on March 14, 2016.
